A local shop and popular pub/restaurant are also within easy walking distance. A good size level garden compliments the outside space along with brick-built storage sheds. Ynyswen is a small village located in the Upper Swansea Valley, near Penycae. The area is situated at the foot of Cribarth consists mostly of ex-local authority housing. A local shop is within walking distance and the popular Ancient Briton pub/restaurant is a little further up the road. Ynyswen enjoys rural views in all directions lying at the foot of the Cribarth ridge and there are plenty of country walks nearby as well as Craig Y Nos Country Park a short drive away.

Neighbouring Ystradgynlais provides a bustling central shopping area with many unique, family-run, independent shops and cafés as well as larger chain stores and supermarkets located on the outskirts.

Bedroom Three 2.71 m x 3.90 m 8'11" x 12'10" approx Window to rear. Radiator.

Bedroom Four 2.16 m x 2.62 m (7'1" x 8'7") approx (excluding recess) Window to front. Radiator.

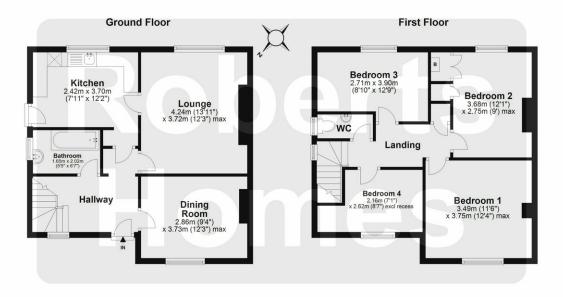
W.C 1.95 m x 0.84 m (6'5" x 2'9") approx Wash hand basin and w.c Window to side. Radiator.

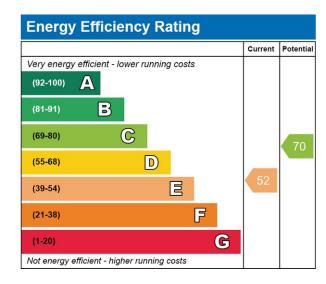
